Updates from the last 3 weeks were shared:

- Really good response on commitment forms.

Discussed and finalized updates to the plan:

- Specialized classroom areas and extracurricular activities
- Cleaning/sanitizing/disinfecting agents
- Disclaimer about Schoology
- Schoology is mentioned throughout the plan, so we wanted to let parents know that we do not have this from TEA right now.
- Extenuating circumstances will be handled on a case by case basis and with required documentation completed and administrative approval.

- Discussion - Page 10 Protocols for personal protective equipment/masks - change the wording to 4<sup>th</sup> grade and above or change to 10 years and above. The committee decided to go with 4<sup>th</sup> grade and above so it doesn't single out students who might be older in a 3<sup>rd</sup> grade classroom. 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> are in the same hallway, so that it makes sense.
