

District Communication to parents on August 1, 2020

This was emailed and texted out to parents on August 1. An automated phone call was also sent to parents.

Henrietta ISD looks forward to welcoming all students back to school on Thursday, August 20.

Due to current circumstances, families have a choice of two learning options for instruction for the 2020-2021 school year. Families may choose on-campus instruction or remote instruction. Each family will need to consider which option is best for their child and then complete the commitment form. **The deadline for submitting your child's commitment form is Thursday, August 6, 2020.**

Please make sure you have read the HISD Strong Start Plan and understand both options before making your choice. The plan is posted on the Strong Start portion of the [Henrietta ISD web page](#).

As a reminder, the guidelines for remote learning are EXPONENTIALLY MORE RIGOROUS than last spring. Academic expectations for remote learners will mirror on-campus activities in rigor and amount of work. Daily attendance and participation is necessary and will be recorded each day.

Parents/Students who choose remote instruction are committing to that learning pathway for the first six weeks grading period. Parents/guardians will be allowed the opportunity to select and/or change their student's learning pathway two weeks prior to the start of each six weeks grading period throughout the school year. Reminders will be communicated.

This commitment form is mandatory and must be completed for each student enrolled at Henrietta ISD regardless of whether you are choosing on campus or remote instruction. Not only does this form allow you to designate your choice of instructional pathway, but it gives us crucial information in case the district has to move to fully remote instruction for all students at some point during the year.
