010309 The meeting was called to order by Rex Taylor, President of the Board of Trustees.

020309 The invocation was given by Danny Kelton

Rex Taylor expressed thanks for the concern shown during his father's time of illness.

030309 There was no one desiring to address the board.

040109 Construction Report – Glenda Ramsey and Kevin Darnell presented an update on the ongoing phases of the construction project.

050109 Consider bids received by Kevin Darnell (CMAR) for a bus barn and new baseball/softball complex (05457.07).

060109 A motion was made by Lanny Evans and seconded by Billy Johnson to accept the guaranteed maximum price bid of \$113,176.31 for construction of bus barn. The motion carried. The vote 7-0.

090109 Administration Report of Student Activities and Events

090109.1 Elementary Principal – Kendra Bennett – Newsletter was distributed to board members listing February activities. Chili Cook-off was a great success. 1st round of TAKS tests have been given and everything went well. We are anxiously awaiting our scores. Four staff members attended the Inclusion Works Conference in Austin a few weeks ago. We came back excited and with lots of great differentiation ideas. A faculty meeting was held yesterday to explain those.

090109.2 Middle School Principal – Quana West reported that March has been a busy month with track meets and other activities. The 7th and 8th graders have taken the reading and writing TAKS tests and we are about to test on other subjects when we return from Spring Break. The 8th graders attended the Career Safari in Wichita Falls on Wednesday. Nicki Holbert sponsored the students as they traveled to MPEC and then Midwestern State University, toured the facilities and ate lunch in the cafeteria. The Student Council members attended a leadership conference at Hirschi last week. Paula Craft sponsored the students as they had the opportunity to attend various workshops during the day. We will have cheerleading tryouts when we return from Spring Break. Tracie Barry is organizing the tryouts and we have around 20 girls participating. The students have practiced tornado and fire drills and are ready in the case of an emergency. The newly constructed "safe hall" in the science wing is very convenient for everyone to access.

090109.3 High School Principal – Gary Parrish reported that on February 26th, thirteen students participated in the Red River Regional Science Fair. Nine of the thirteen students qualified for the state science fair to be held in San Antonio the last weekend of March. The team of Taylor Powell, Jessica Scaling and Jessica Sanchez won the top team award and qualified for the International Science and Engineering Fair to be held in Reno, Nevada during the second week in May. Some or our band members competed at Region UIL solo and ensemble competition in Wichita Falls. All of the Henrietta students that participated received perfect scores. Five members will be advance to the state competition. We have now begun to advertise the Aeronautics Class that will begin next year. We have printed up brochures and even had an article in the Clay County Leader and expect there to be an article in the Times Record News as well as TV stations. Everything is going strong with our Athletic program. All areas are showing improvement over last year. The Softball team recently won two tournaments and are currently 12-3 for the year. Students have also completed the first round of TAKS and are hopeful about the results.
