111114 Administration Report of Student Activities and Events:

111114.1 Elementary Principal – Kendra Bennett distributed newsletters to board members highlighting recent and upcoming activities. HES attendance rate for the first six weeks was 97.7%. Two classes tied for the best class attendance at 99.1%. The fourth grade participated in the Ag in the Classroom day which is sponsored by the Texas Farm Bureau and the Clay County Extension Agency. Lots of fun was had by all during Red Ribbon Week with Drug Education lessons from Mrs. Parrish in the classrooms. Students and teachers are working hard for the upcoming UIL Academic Meet on December 4th. Atmos Energy partnered with the Henrietta and Clay County Chamber of commerce in distributing a free dictionary to every third grader in the county. Third and fifth grade classes have presented their musicals recently, which were wonderful as usual. Second grade will present their musical on November 20th. The PTO recently held a night of pumpkin decorating and then the PTO Fall Carnival. Both events were very well attended by students and their parents. HES will be partnering with high school PALS for their annual canned food drive. Mrs. Bennett reminded everyone present to shop, shop, shop and help HES win the A+ Rewards program once again. Diabetes Awareness will be observed during the month of November. Mrs. Talley has many events planned. Students are encouraged to walk/run for 5 minutes as they enter her classroom. 11114.2 Middle School Principal – Randy Zamzow, Interim Principal, distributed newsletters to board members. The Cross Country Teams recently had their district meet. The Lady Cats finished 2nd place and the Bearcats finished 3rd. Volleyball and football have both completed their seasons with all teams showing much improvement and a lot of success. Red Ribbon Week was a great success for students and staff. All participated in celebrating Drug Free Week through various activities within the classroom and dressing up for theme days. The Red Stegall Poetry Contest was recently held at the Stockyards in Fort Worth. HJH had 4 of the 10 finalist from throughout North Texas. National Junior Honor Society Induction Ceremony was held on November 3rd.

11114.3 High School Principal – Gary Parrish reported that HHS attendance rate for this last six weeks was 96.3%. Students were successful in their academics; 85% of all students passed every course they were involved in and 94.6% passed all but one course. The HHS Band competed in the UIL Region Marching contest in Wichita Falls. They performed extremely well and scored all 1's. This past weekend we had many band students compete in the All-District Band Competition. Twelve students were placed on the All-District Band. Twelve Ag Student Teams competed in District Leadership Event Contests on Wednesday, November 13th. Ten of the teams will be advancing to Area Competition on November 22nd. These results allowed

Henrietta FFA to be again named the 2014 Wichita District FFA Leadership Development Events Sweepstakes winner. We have won the district sweepstakes award four of the last five years. The Annual Senior Halloween Party went very well and they had a blast. Lady Cats Volleyball finished up as Bi-District Champions before falling to Peaster in the Area Round. The Veterans' Day Assembly was held on Tuesday, November 11th. Numerous compliments have been received with some saying this years' program was the best one yet. Honored in the program was local Purple Heart recipient Graham Wilson. Mr. Wilson received an extended standing ovation from those in attendance. Our student body was simply outstanding in their display of conduct and respect for those who served our country. The softball field surface is complete and fence work is the only thing remaining to complete this project. The baseball field is progressing nicely. The turf should be complete by second or third week in December. The restrooms in the metal building are complete. The lights in the auditorium are currently in progress. The sound system at the football field is being analyzed and we will be moving forward with repairing or replacing those in the near future.
