010816 The meeting was called to order by Paul Bennett, President of the Board of Trustees.

020816 Invocation was given by Betty Ellsworth.

030816 There was no one desiring to address the board.

040816 A motion was made by Lanny Evans and seconded by Betty Ellsworth to levy or set the tax rate on \$100 valuation for the District for the current tax year at a total tax rate of \$1.31, to be assessed and collected by the duly specified assessor and collectors as follows: \$1.04 for the purpose of maintenance and operation, and \$0.27 for the purpose of payment of principal and interest on debts. The motion carried. The vote 6-0.

050816 Public hearing for expenditure of Title I Funds.

060816 A motion was made by Kelly Beeler seconded by Billy Johnson to approve Title I expenditures for 2015-2016 as presented. The motion carried. The vote 6-0.

070816 A motion was made by Lanny Evans and seconded by Betty Ellsworth to approve Title I funds for 2016-2017 as presented. The motion carried. The vote 6-0.

080816 A motion was made by Billy Johnson and seconded by Nala Chambers to approve TASB Policy Update 105. The motion carried. The vote 6-0.

090817 A motion was made by Nala Chambers and seconded by Billy Johnson to approve a Resolution regarding Extracurricular Status of Archer County 4-H Organization and Adjunct Faculty Appointment for 2016-2017. The motion carried. The vote 5-1, Kelly Beeler voted against the motion.

100816 Administration Report of Students Activities and Events

100816.1 Elementary Principal – Kendra Bennett reported that all of the HES staff received "Capturing Kids Hearts" training last week. Board members received a hand out highlighting this program along with a copy of the staff letter. The additional day of in-service allowed extra time in getting staff ready for new school year. The gym looks completely different with the

new floor, paint and new mats. Photos were shown of the gym and Kindergarten/1<sup>st</sup> grade restroom remodel. New storage cabinets have been added to the Science lab. It looks nice and helps with the organization of the room. The new playground surface is in place, the new equipment has been ordered, and installation is scheduled for next Tuesday. The staff has been working together to get everything cleaned and organized for the new year. The annual bulletin board night was last Monday. The theme for this year is "HES – You Matter". Class list were posted tonight. Meet the Teacher and Parent Orientation will be on Monday, August 15<sup>th</sup> from 5:30 – 6:00, followed by two Parent Orientation sessions at 6:00-6:30 p.m. and 6:30 – 7:00 p.m. Due to lower than average enrollment numbers in our Pre-K classes, we opened up the classes for non-eligible students. Non-eligible students will pay \$460 per month to attend. As of today, eight students have enrolled into this program.

100816.2 Middle School Principal – Randy Zamzow reported that band hall foundation has been poured and framework is going up. A security door has been ordered and will be installed at the entrance of the main building. The tennis court lines will be painted and new nets hung, the benches outside the building will receive new boards and paint.

100816.3 High School Principal – Michael Smiley presented board members with a copy of the summer update that was sent to staff. The information outlined the daily schedule of activities for the in-service days. Mr. Smiley commended Shane Crafton for being elected President of the Vocational Agriculture Teachers Association of Texas (VATAT) for the 2016-2017 school year. "Meet the Cats" was on Tuesday of this week. Returning student registration and schedule pick up was on Wednesday and new student registration is scheduled for Friday, August 12<sup>th</sup>. The Bearcat Band Community Preview will be Thursday, August 18<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. Bearcat football will have a scrimmage on Friday evening against Burkburnett; Lady Cat Volleyball will be in tournament play in Burkburnett on Friday and Saturday. Cross Country will have their first competition on September 3<sup>rd</sup> in Boyd. The cheerleaders have been working extremely hard getting the halls spirited up. The student council has been at the school and have assisting with registration, assembling staff notebooks and preparing a Teacher Appreciation Station to welcome the staff back. There are 58 students athletes participating in football, 32 for volleyball, 15 in cross-country and 61 in band.
