010817 The meeting was called to order by Billy Johnson, President of the Board of Trustees.

020817 Invocation was given by Lanny Evans.

030817 There was no one desiring to address the board.

040817 A motion was made by Betty Ellsworth and seconded by Penny Riordan to levy or set the tax rate on \$100 valuation for the District for the current tax year at a total tax rate of \$1.31, to be assessed and collected by the duly specified assessor and collectors as follows: \$1.04 for the purpose of maintenance and operation, and \$0.27 for the purpose of payment of principal and interest on debts. The motion carried. The vote 7-0.

050817 Public hearing for expenditure of Title I Funds.

060817 A motion was made by Penny Riordan seconded by Nala Chambers to approve Title I expenditures for 2016-2017 and the 2017-2018 budget as presented. The motion carried. The vote 7-0.

070817 A motion was made by Paul Bennett and seconded by Penny Riordan to approve the Employee Handbook with revisions as presented. The motion carried. The vote 7-0.

090817 A motion was made by Penny Riordan and seconded by Betty Ellsworth to accept bid from Ashley Douglass for gas and diesel for 2017-2018 as low bid at \$.15 above cost per gallon. The motion carried. The vote 7-0.

100817 Administration Report of Students Activities and Events

100817.1 Elementary Principal – Kendra Bennett reported that teachers are back and ready to go. Some painting has been done in a few hallways and there are still a few reoccurring leaks that are being addressed. Annual bulletin board night was last Monday and everything is coming together. Five new staff members are in a Capturing Kids' Hearts training today and tomorrow in Gainesville. The rest of the campus completed the Capturing Kids' Hearts refresher today. As of today, enrollment is at 460. Monday, August 14th is Meet the Teacher at 5:30 – 6:30 and

Parent Orientation at 6:00 - 6:30 and 6:30-7:00. First day of school will be on Thursday, August 17^{th} . Pre-K has opened up for non-eligible students. A few will be able to attend and will be paying tuition.

100817.2 Middle School Principal – Terry McCutchen reported that there are still a few leaks that are a work in progress. The band hall has been carpeted and is ready to go.
