010419 The meeting was called to order by Lanny Evans, President of the Board of Trustees.

020419 The invocation was given by Nala Chambers.

030419 There was no one desiring to address the board.

040419 Julie Wuthrich was recognized as the Shining Star for April.

050419 Billy Johnson was recognized for his 18 years of service to the board. HISD has been honored to have him serve on the board. He was presented with a watch as a token of our appreciation.

090419 Administration Report of Student Activities and Events

090419.1 Elementary Principal: Kendra Bennett stated that HES celebrated Epilepsy Awareness Day and also Autism Awareness Day this month.
